PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

Johnson County, Tennessee has received a US Department of Housing and Urban Development HOME Disaster Recovery grant from the Tennessee Housing Development Agency (THDA) to rehabilitate homes affected by Hurricane Helene. This work will be completed by area contractors and will be at minimal cost to QUALIFYING homeowners.

A public meeting has been scheduled to discuss this program with interested citizens. Work to be completed will be substantial, and include reconstruction, roofing, foundations, siding, windows, doors, flooring, etc.

All of the following criteria must be met to qualify: 1. Incurred damage due to Hurricane Helene. 2. Meet low-to-moderate income guidelines. 3. Have proof that you own the home and the land on which it is located. 4. Lived in / owned the home for a minimum of one year prior to the disaster. 5. Reside permanently within Johnson County, Tennessee and property taxes are paid up-to-date.

If you meet these criteria and are interested in obtaining more information about the grant, please come to a public information session. For the residents of **Johnson County** it will be held on **Wednesday, April 2nd at 10:30 AM** at National Guard Armory, 1923 S Shady Street, Mountain City, Tennessee 37683.
